## What are the priorities for the Fund?

The Fund will support projects that:



Enhance the environmental health of Port Phillip Bay



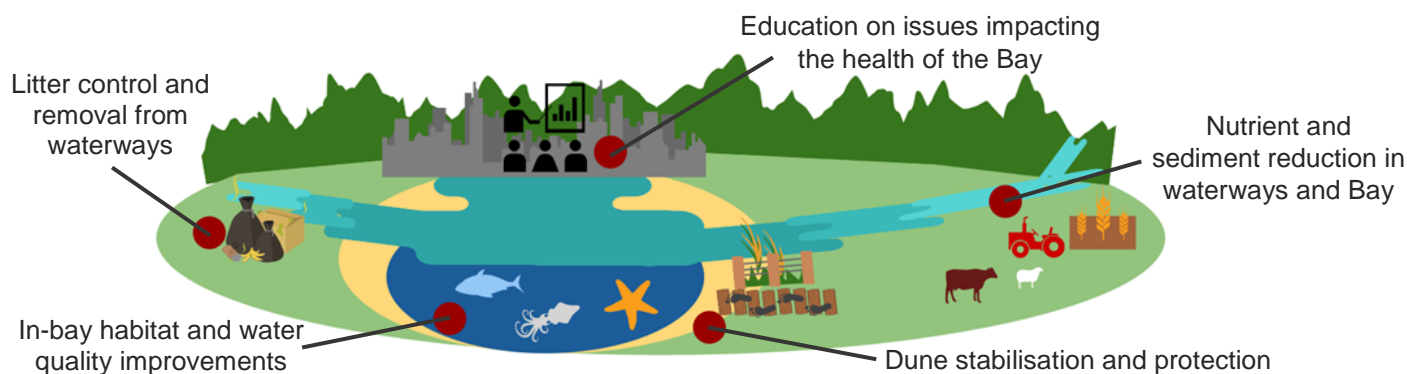
Encourage partnerships between groups and organisations with an interest in the health of the Bay



Reduce threats to the Bay, such as nutrients and litter

## What types of activities may be funded?

There are many types of activities that may be funded, including those shown below. Activities must be within the Port Phillip Bay catchment area and clearly contribute to the environmental health of Port Phillip Bay.



## Which grant can I apply for?



### I'm applying as a volunteer-based community group

Such as a Friends, Coastcare or Landcare group, an Indigenous group or association, or a social, service or recreational group (e.g. Rotary, Senior, Scouts, Boating)

### Community Small Grants

Single year projects, up to \$10,000

### Community Large Grants

1-3 year projects, up to \$50,000 per year



### I'm applying as a not-for-profit organisation

Such as a charitable organisation, Committee of Management, Catchment Management Authority, tertiary and research institution, local council or State Government agency.

### Organisation & Partnership Grants

1-3 year projects, up to \$100,000 per year



### I'm applying as an individual or a for-profit company

Such as a business, sole trader, or land owner

### Not eligible to apply individually

Can partner with an eligible organisation
